Forces Online is a small nationwide cross-border charity set up to help our nation's military Veterans their families and dependents in times of hardship and need.

We offer you a fantastic opportunity to help identify local opportunities to engage with your local community and to network with supporters. You'll help us to raise funds by coordinating suitable Location Nationwide in the United Kingdom (Excluding Northern Ireland) for collection tins and buckets and managing the funds collected.

About the Role

Our Volunteer Collection Tin Coordinators are countrywide and can be based anywhere in the United Kingdom (Except Northern Ireland) to represent Forces Online in their own areas. Initially you will be provided with an ID, DBS, email, promotional and collection items. Full training and expenses will be provided. Ideally you will already have connections with the armed forces and local communities. Support will be provided by our central administrational team and online portal. Opportunities to develop and manage your own County-based team will be available for the right candidates.

What you are doing

- You'll engage heavily with the local community by having regular contact with our supporters.
- You'll actively look for potential opportunities to make connections with new supporters.
- You'll show a dynamic approach to helping to raise the profile of the charity.
- You'll find suitable places within the local community to place collection tins and buckets, retrieving and replacing as necessary, counting, and banking all funds following collection.

- Have confidence in approaching potential supporters in the local community

- Have experience of handling money and banking or would like to gain skills in this
 area.
- Have a passion for fundraising and helping the Armed Forces Community.
